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# **2010 BEIJING INTERNATIONAL MUSIC FESTIVAL & ACADEMY**

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Building on its great success in recent history, the highly acclaimed **Beijing International Music Festival & Academy (BIMFA)** will celebrate its fifth anniversary season from **August 11 to 24, 2010** in the historic capital of Beijing. It promises to be another exceptional experience in both music and culture for young musicians seeking to explore their fullest potentials in life.

Established in 2004, **Beijing International Music Festival & Academy (BIMFA)** is the first and the only annual international summer music festival of its kind today in the People's Republic of China. Open to **Pianists, String Players** and **Flutists** of all nationalities, BIMFA brings together established performing artists, pedagogues and serious music students from around the world in a unique collaboration in music to promote high-level teaching, performance and cultural harmony. In addition, BIMFA's extensive cultural and excursion programs offer participants multiple opportunities for exploration and discovery in the ancient land of China.

### **Program**

Our Festival offers an intensive schedule, focusing on close student-faculty collaboration through individual study and ensemble performance. It includes:

- *Individual lessons twice weekly*
- *Coached chamber ensembles and group classes*
- *Opportunities to participate in Master Class Series and Lectures/Seminars*
- *Festival pass to observe all master classes, individual teaching and chamber music coaching*
- *Free admission to all concerts by artist-faculty, acclaimed artists and festival participants*
- *Multiple opportunities for public performance including Gala Concert, Young Artists' Concerts, Noon Showcase for individuals and selected ensembles.*
- *Eligibility to enter the Concerto Competition, winners to be presented in the Gala Finale Concert.*

### **Faculty**

The artist-faculty is comprised of celebrated international artists and teachers from prestigious music schools and conservatories around the world, in addition to the renowned Chinese professors and performers in today's music scene in China.

### **Professional Division**

The 2010 program is open to **pianists, string players** (violin, viola, cello & double bass) and **flutists** of all nationalities, age 14 and up, including college/graduate students, high school and young professionals. Gifted young musicians under age 14 may also be considered, but a parent/guardian must accompany them during the festival. Participants are accepted after an evaluation of their applications and audition materials.

### **Extension Division**

Now in the 5<sup>th</sup> anniversary, with the newly established “Extension Division”, BIMFA opens its doors for the first time to welcome and include players of all ages, **amateur adult, teens/children under 14** and **auditors** for a lifelong experience of music making in the musically infused Chinese environment, while surrounded by one of the most fascinating cultures of the world. ### **Concerto Competition**

The Concerto Competition offers students a special opportunity for public recognition. Participants must be fully registered festival students to enter.

- **1st Prize: \$500** award with possibility to perform with a Chinese professional orchestra or the Festival Orchestra in future seasons.
- **2nd Prize: \$250** award
- **3rd Prize: \$100** award

### **Venue**

The 2010 Festival will take place on the campus of the prestigious Music School of the Central Conservatory in Beijing for 2 weeks. Participants will reside in the Conservatory guesthouse, which is equipped with air-conditioning and private bathroom with shower. Two to three participants will share a room and three meals are served daily in BIMFA cafe/restaurant.

### **Cultural Excursions**

The historic city of **Beijing** is the capital of the People's Republic of China and the country's cultural, political and transportation center. Geographically located in the northern part of China, Beijing is an ancient city with a long cultural history and the second largest Chinese city with a population of more than 11 million. Served as the capital for four Chinese dynasties - Jin, Yuan, Ming and Qing, Beijing possesses unparalleled scenic and historical sites that inspire exploration leading to better understanding of Chinese history, culture and the arts, and was the host city for the 2008 Olympic Games. As a special part of the cultural experience, BIMFA will organize at least four excursions\* in the Beijing vicinity from the following list:

- *Great Wall of China*
- *Forbidden City (Palace Museum) & Tiananmen Square*
- *Summer Palace or Temple of Heaven*
- *Hutong Tour & Drum Tower*
- *Performance either of a Chinese acrobatic troupe or a traditional Chinese variety show*

\*All excursion expenses (site entrance admission, local transportation, gratuities to local tour guides and translators) are **included** in the fees paid by each fully registered participant.

### **Application Procedures**

All applications must include the following:

- *A completed application form*
- *An audition Tape/CD/DVD of free repertoire to determine applicant's placement and level of proficiency*
- *A letter of recommendation from your current teacher if you do not study regularly with BIMFA faculty member*
- *A non-refundable application fee plus a **deposit of \$300** (\*Please see fees and payment schedule below)*

All admission materials should be mailed together and postmarked by the deadlines listed below. We encourage all interested candidates to apply as early as possible. Notification of acceptance is made on a continuing basis, normally no later than 2-3 weeks after the receipt of your application. Late applications will only be considered if spaces are available. Please make check/money order in U.S. dollars payable to **BIMFA**.

### **Scholarship**

Limited tuition scholarship assistance may be available for highly qualified students in the professional division. **A written request** for financial assistance with your application, audition tape, recommendation letter and a nonrefundable application fee must all be received together by **March 1st** before evaluation can take place, regardless of whether or not you already study with a member of BIMFA faculty.

### **Fees, Payments Schedule & Refund Policy**

#### **Nonrefundable Application Fees**

- **No application fee** for former BIMFA participants and all auditors/parents
- \$30 postmarked on or before **February 28**
- \$60 postmarked between **March 1 to 31**
- \$80 postmarked between **April 1 to 30**
- Late application after **May 1** only accepted pending space availability with \$100 late fee.

- **Extension Division**

\$1100 for 1-week program from Aug. 11-17, 2010

\$1900 for 2-week program from Aug. 11-24, 2010

**Extension Division Fees** are inclusive of deposit, tuition, room and board, festival pass, concert-series admission, practice facilities, all excursion expenses with local transportation, plus roundtrip airport transfers.

- **Auditor/Parent\***

\$1100 for 2-week program in Beijing from Aug. 10-22, 2010

**Auditor/Parent Fees** are inclusive of deposit, room and board, festival pass, concert-series admission, all Excursion expenses with local transportation, plus roundtrip airport transfers.

\*Auditor/parent only needs to fill out an application form (indicating auditor or parent) with the required deposit.

## Payment Schedule

- All application must include a nonrefundable application fee along with a refundable deposit of **\$300\*** before any evaluation can take place.
- All remaining balance is due on **May 15, 2010**.
